

Perspective or Opinion Pieces (Sample)

Perspective or Opinion Pieces should be structured in the following order: 1) Introduction, 2) Relevance 3) Authors perspective, and 4) Discussion. **Word count should be no more than 1,000 words.**

Author's details

- The name of the author (first and last name) and highest degree earned.
Example: Ahmed Al-Kareej, M.S.
- Email address of reviewer (mandatory for correspondence).

Introduction (100 words)

- What does the Opinion Piece address? What is its topic?
- Which readers does it address?
- What's the background information (if any) that helps readers to understand the context?

Relevance (100 words)

- Why does the topic of this '*Perspective or Opinion Piece*' matter?
- What makes it relevant to the readers?
- What are things the readers need to consider if/when they try to apply the takeaways from the Op-ed in their contexts?

Authors' perspective (500 words)

- What does the author use/employ to make their perspective/opinion clear and convincing, e.g. evidence-based data from published research, practice-based data, etc.?

Discussion (300 words)

- How does the author discuss their views in relation to other known givens?
- What are the key takeaways from the Opinion Piece?
