

Research Study (Sample)

Research papers including action research article submissions should be structured in the following order: title, abstract, keywords, main text (introduction, materials and methods, results, discussion, acknowledgements, conflict of interest statement, references). **Word count should be no more than 6,500 words.**

Title

Title of the Article

Abstract

A summary of the entire article including background, methods, results, and conclusions. **(150-250 words)**

Keywords

5-7 key words

Introduction

Provides an overview of the topic, context, purpose of the study, significance, and specific objectives of the study (i.e. research questions). **(1,000-2,000 words)**

Material and Methods

A detailed description of the procedures, participants, materials, and data collection methods, and analysis. **(1,000-1,500 words)**

Results

The interpretation of the results which includes relating them to existing literature and discusses their implications. **(1,000-1,500 words)**

Discussion

A discussion of the key findings, limitations, and their implications in educational context(s). **(500-750 words)**

Conclusions

A summary of findings and recommendations. **(500-1000 words)**
